All aircraft may bomb at low altitude. Treat as dive bomber, but hit for d6 throw of 5 or 6. Can be driven off by anti-aircraft fire.

* In action against Poland in 1940 and Russia up to Autumn 1941. In Summer 1942 some aircraft were deployed against Soviet partisans. In October 1944 surviving planes supported the Slovakian national uprising against the Germans.

**109s were used from late '42 to mid-late '43 supporting German forces, but withdrawn due to the high number of desertions. Some flew against the Germans during the uprising.

NB Other aircraft types were supplied, but were either used in very small numbers or not deployed in combat roles.
