| 105mm MAVAG 40M howitzer | AT class 3 / HE 12 points table 4 | 12 | Very small number. Gun equipped the Zrinyi assault gun |

| 150mm 14/39M (Skoda) howitzer | HE 12 points table 5 | 14 | Modified Skoda 14M |

| 305mm 16M (Skoda) howitzer | HE 12 points table 5 | 14 | Very few in service. Use uncertain. IDF only |
